

The first time you use the DVD ...

The first screen

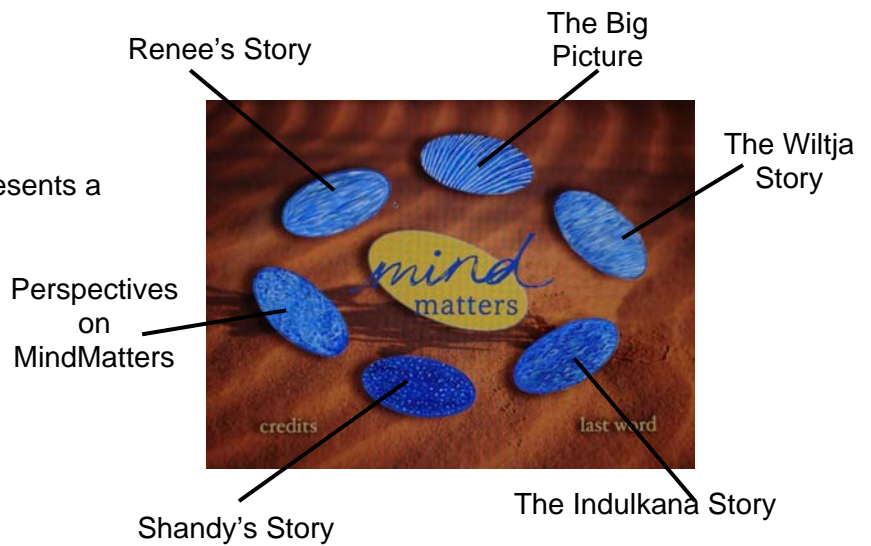


This screen comes up automatically and lasts for 30 seconds.

Note: This screen will not come up again after the DVD has been seen in one sitting. This screen will only reappear if the DVD player has been turned off and the DVD restarted.

The main menu screen ...

Each of the ovals here represents a separate story.



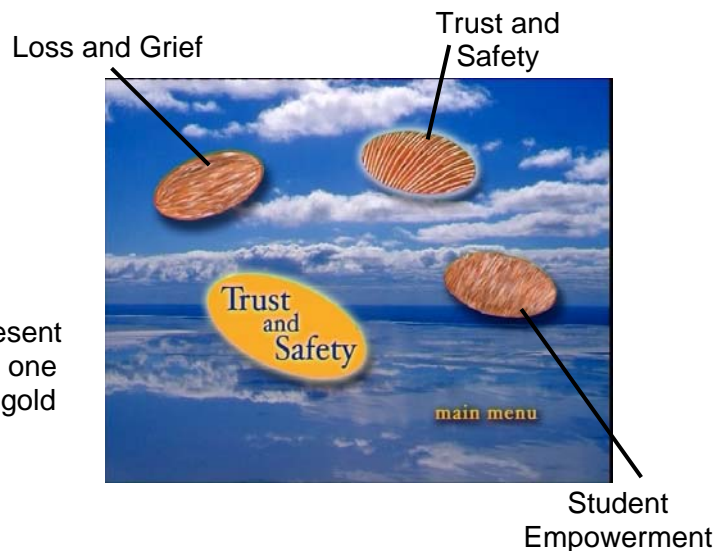
When you click on one of the ovals, the title of that story appears in the gold circle and the oval is highlighted.



The third screen ...

Clicking on the *Perspectives on MindMatters* oval takes you to this second menu screen.

The three ovals on this screen represent separate stories. When you click on one of the ovals, the title appears in the gold oval.



What's in the 'last word' segment?

Clicking on the **last word** will give you a short piece (under two minutes) on the importance of encouraging Aboriginal students into the health profession.



At the conclusion of any of the stories you will be taken back to the main menu (or *Perspectives on MindMatters* menu)

The length of each piece appears in the DVD Handbook.

Troubleshooting

The *CommunityMatters* DVD has been tested on a wide range of different commercial DVD players and DVD-enabled computers, but it is still possible that you may have difficulties playing it on some machines.

Below are some points to keep in mind if the DVD does not play properly.

- 1) Remove the DVD from the player and turn the power off for at least 10 seconds and then turn the power on again. This can be enough to reset the DVD player.
- 2) If you suspect the DVD needs cleaning, use a non-abrasive cleaner on a soft cloth and clean the DVD from the centre outwards.
